













## General Ulysses S. Grant

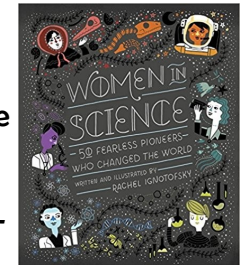
**Wednesday, March 21, 6:30 pm**

Retired U.S. Marine and living historian Kenneth Serfass will bring this famous Union Commanding General to life. Call the library to register.

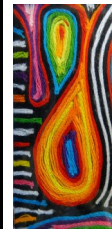
## Mother Daughter Science Book Club Night
